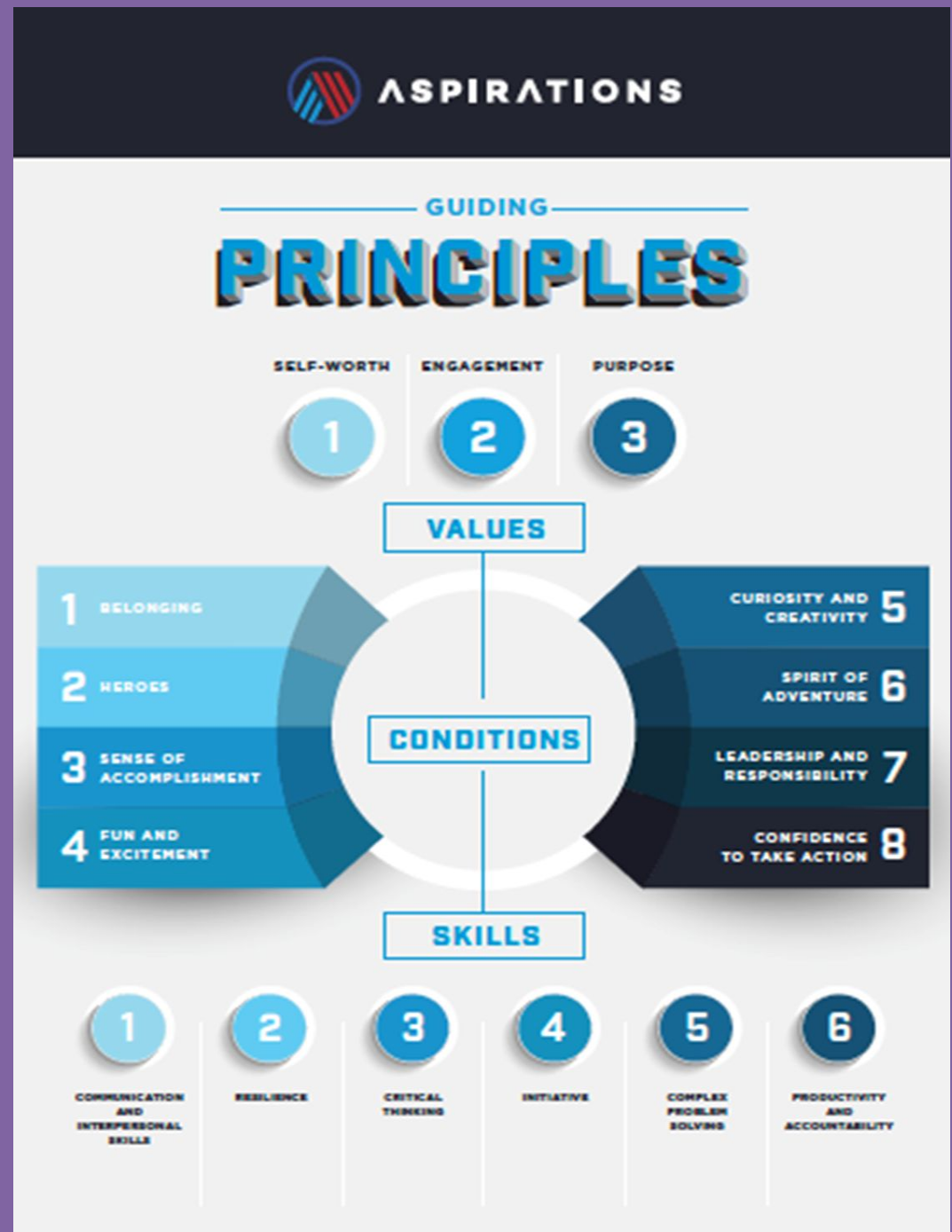

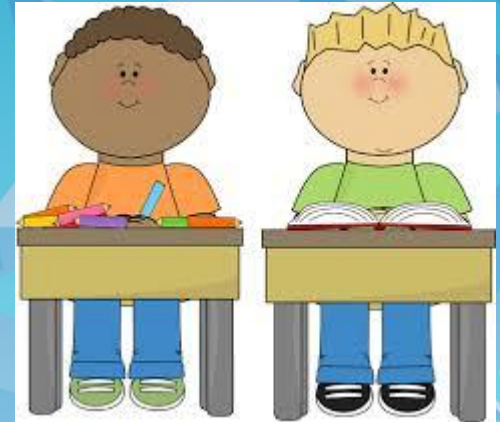

Welcome back, we hope you've had a great holiday.

In our new topic, we will be taking on the role of tour guides, learning about the Geography of Bournemouth and working together to create a persuasive presentation to deliver remotely to Dashwood Academy Banbury.

OUR DRIVING QUESTION:

How can we, as travel agents, encourage visitors to Bournemouth?

AS READERS:
