Destination: Italy!



Driving Question:

How can we, as tour guides, promote a trip to Italy?

Launch:

We will launch our topic by exploring different aspects of Italy. During our Italian themed day we will find out what makes Italy special and investigate their food, music and culture!

Overview:

In our new topic, we will be taking on the role of tour guides! We will be learning about the human and physical Geography of Italy and working together to create promotional digital presentations to persuade people to visit.



Computing

We will use the Green Screen to deliver a persuasive pitch to Year 4 children from Ocean Academy.

Geography

We will explore the human and physical features of Italy and compare the city of Naples with Bournemouth.

English

We will identify the persuasive features needed when creating a speech to encourage visitors to Italy.

Learning conversations to have at home:

Discuss with your child the word Europe. What is it? Where is it? How many countries are in Europe? Do they know where <u>Italy</u> is in Europe? Use <u>Google Maps</u> or an Atlas at home to locate Italy.

Italy is a peninsula (an area of land that sticks out into the sea). It is surrounded by the Adriatic Sea in the east, the Tyrrhenian Sea in the west and the Ionian Sea to the south. It is a popular holiday destination due to its famous landmarks.

Take a trip to a travel agent or look online and pick up some brochures all about Italy. Which brochures were the most persuasive and why?

Persuasive features: colourful or eye catching, emotive language, alliteration, rhetorical questions, repeated words, snappy slogans, humour.

Create a fact file about a famous
Italian city of your choice. This
can be presented in any creative
way and must include information
about that City. For extra house
points, create a 3D model of a
famous Italian landmark!

We will be joined by a special visitor from the tourism industry who will share their job role as well as lots of examples of jobs in tourism.


Landing:
