RE: School lunches - COVID 19 - ACTION REQUIRED BY PARENTS BY 4th SEPTEMBER.

Dear Parents/carers,

All children in Reception to Year 2 are entitled to Universal Infant Meals, which are meals the school provides.

Historically at Jewell, it has been an expectation that all children in these year groups will have a school meal and not a packed lunch from home.

From 1st September 2020, this will no longer be the case and parents/carers may choose whether their child has a meal provided by the school, or if they would prefer to provide their child with a packed lunch.

In the current climate, we are unable to provide any hot meals. This is being reviewed in time for November 2020.

Therefore if you choose a cold, packed lunch for your child in Reception - Year 2 under the Universal Infant Meals scheme, or if your child is entitled to Free School Meals (FSM), you will need to book these via this form <https://forms.gle/ezhjEghdYBG1U5458> no later than 4th September for the weeks ahead.

A typical meal will consist of:

Cheese, tuna or meat sandwich - dietary requirements are taken into account.

Veggie sticks or coleslaw

Cake or yogurt

Fruit and carton of juice or water.



You may cancel your order by emailing the office at any time.


All lunches will be served in the classrooms.

If you are providing your child with a packed lunch from home, please note that this will be kept in the classroom and we strongly recommend that you include a named freezer block in their boxes to keep meat or dairy products cool.

Please also provide your child with the necessary cutlery such as spoons for yogurt.

We cannot refrigerate or heat any food for your child.
