Dear Parents and Carers,

We are very much looking forward to welcoming everyone back to school safely on March 8th 2021.

The car park gate will open as usual from 8:30am and we encourage all KS2 children (Y3 and above) to walk in by themselves. An adult may accompany younger children.

We ask that only one adult where possible does drop off and pick up. Please wear face masks on site (unless exempt) and maintain social distancing at all times. We also respectfully ask that you leave site as soon as possible and do not gather outside classrooms or in the car park to ensure you are following government guidelines.

Please be aware of using the public car park outside of the school and near the shop and community centre. Please do not stop on the yellow lines to drop children off or block other cars in.

Lateness:

Please arrive at school on time.

The gates close at 9am and children arriving later than this will be classed as late which affects their attendance, not to mention how unsettling it is arriving into a class that has already begun learning for the day.

Lateness will be monitored very carefully from 8th March.

HSM:

Please ensure that you have booked (and where required, pay for) your Hot School Meals on ParentPay. The deadline for booking these is the Tuesday the week before the meal is needed.

Covid reporting:

If your child or any member of your household displays symptoms of CV19, the entire household must isolate immediately and book a test. Please do communicate to us if you are having to isolate and any subsequent test results. This can be done by emailing covidreporting@jewell-aspirations.org

It is essential you do this so that we can take the appropriate action in closing bubbles if necessary to keep ourselves and other families safe.
