Launch:

Overview:

In our new topic, we will be taking on the role of travel agents! We will be learning about the geography of Bournemouth and working together to create a persuasive presentation to encourage Year 2 children to come and visit our beautiful town of Bournemouth!

Learning conversations to have at home:

Create a list of different jobs in tourism. Why are they important to Bournemouth?

Travel agents: help people to plan tours or itineraries and share exciting places to visit in our area. Restaurant managers and chefs: people on holiday often go out for meals. Restaurant managers and chefs ensure tourists have a range of quality food options to choose from. Lifeguards: one of the main reasons tourists come to Bournemouth is to visit the beach; lifeguards keep us safe in the water.

Take a trip to Bournemouth Tourism Office and pick up some free leaflets all about our local attractions. Which leaflets were the most persuasive and why?

Persuasive features may include: colourful or eye catching imagery or writing, emotive language, alliteration, rhetorical questions, repeated words, snappy slogans and humour.

Topic Home learning:

Take a trip to Bournemouth town centre! Why do you think so many people come to visit our brilliant town? Create a visual representation of your favourite tourist attraction. You could show this by using a shoe box to create a model or you could draw a picture. Due on or before:

Landing:

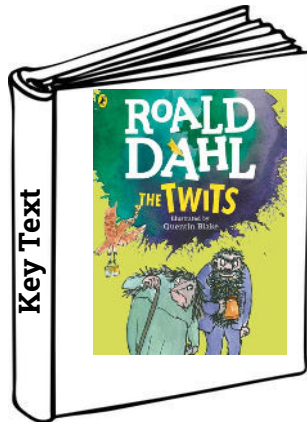
We will be sharing our amazing persuasive presentations in a bid to encourage people to come and visit Bournemouth to see all of its fantastic attractions.

How can you help at home?

- At home or out and about, encourage children to come up with different adjectives to describe what you see.
- Pick up leaflets for different attractions and talk about what makes them appealing to visitors.

Maths

- ★ Mass and capacity.

How can you help at home?

- Talk to your child about how different foods (for example: pizza) can be cut up and divided into equal portions.
- Discuss with your child about how different measurements are used in everyday life.

Science

We are learning about the importance of nutrition and how vital it is to live healthily.

Geography

We are learning about the different uses for land and we are also learning how to use grid references.

Music

We are learning to sing and perform the reggae classic "3 Little Birds", including accompanying notes on the glockenspiel.

PSHE

Our topic is 'Healthy Me' and we will be learning about how to live healthy and active lifestyles.

Design and Technology

We are learning about levers and mechanisms. We will be using these in our lessons.

Computing

We are learning how to stay safe online. We will also be learning how to use a green screen to create simple adverts.

Physical Education - Indoor PE

We are learning about how dance and gymnastic movements can be sequenced together to create routines.

Physical Education - Outdoor PE

We are learning about using a racket to participate in net/wall games.

Spanish

We are learning how to say names of fruit, which links with our Science and PSHE units.

Religious Education

We are learning about the Christian celebration of Easter and how the festival teaches us about forgiveness.
