How can we, as local residents, ensure that others understand the importance of our river?


Launch: Trip to the Kingfisher barn at the River Stour on Monday 15th April to learn about wildlife found in and around rivers

We will delve deep into a non-fiction based reading project surrounding rivers and produce a range of different tasks to support our understanding.


